Dear Ms. Chrzanowski:

In compliance with the Nevada Supreme Court's Decision filed on June 12, 2008, I wish to offer to you this formal and sincere apology for my non-willful conduct that occurred in my courtroom on Monday, March 31, 2003.

Specifically, I apologize for the misunderstanding that occurred between myself and the Marshal, arising from your boyfriend, Joshua Madera's failure to comply with prior Court orders and his failure to pay unpaid traffic tickets. I apologize for the fact that following your departure from my courtroom, you were handcuffed by the Marshal and held in a woman's holding cell for approximately two hours awaiting the arrival of your boyfriend Joshua Madera, whom you had come to Court to represent on that date. I apologize further for the anxiety that you incurred as a result of the Marshal's refusal to let you call your work and to let your work know that you would likely be unable to work that evening. None of the Marshal's behavior was anticipated by me, nor intended by me. As the Nevada Supreme Court has found, my conduct was non-willful and was of an isolated nature.

I want you to know further that I have dedicated my life to the administration of justice and to do justice. I have done so both as a lawyer for many years and as a Municipal Court Judge. I have never been charged with any impropriety both before this incident or


