9 APPLICATION FOR A NEW CERTIFICATE

10 Through this application (the "Application"), Venetian Limousine Services, LLC (the
11 "Applicant") seeks a certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing the Applicant to
12 operate as a common motor carrier of passengers under Section 706.386 of the Nevada Revised
13 Statutes ("NRS"). The Application is made pursuant to NRS 706.391 and Section 706.1375 of
14 the Nevada Administrative Code ("NAC"). The Application is based on the Memorandum of
15 Statements and Attachments (the "Memorandum"), accompanying and incorporated into this
16 Application.

17 The Applicant proposes to provide point-to-point service over irregular routes within
18 Clark County. Specifically, Venetian Limousine proposes to provide the following services: (1)
19 transportation of customers, guests and patrons of the The Venetian and The Palazzo (the
20 "Properties") and their baggage in limousines by prearranged charter order pursuant to which the
21 customer, guest or patron pays the Applicant for such service, either directly or indirectly; and,
22 (2) transportation of customers, guests and patrons of the Properties and their baggage in
23 limousines by a prearranged charter order pursuant to which one of the Applicant's affiliates
24 pays for the service through an inter-company charge. The Applicant will stage its vehicles and
25 provide transportation service on a walk-up basis at the Properties. The Properties, however, are
26 the only locations at which Venetian Limousine will stage its vehicles and provide service on a
27 walk-up basis.

28 Based on this Application, the Memorandum and Exhibits A through U, the Applicant

1 respectfully requests that the Authority issue an order granting Applicant a certificate of public
2 convenience and necessity to operate as a common motor carrier of passengers under NRS
3 706.386.

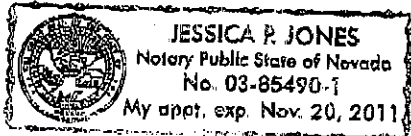



Exhibit A

Venetian Limousine Services, LLC ("Venetian Limousine"), does not currently provide transportation services. Venetian Limousine's affiliate, Las Vegas Sands, LLC ("LVS LLC"), provides complimentary transportation services to customers, guests, casino hosts, key employees, officers and directors of The Venetian and The Palazzo (the "Properties"),¹ under Section 706.741 of the Nevada Revised Statutes ("NRS"). LVS LLC uses two Rolls Royce limousines to provide such transportation services. If Venetian Limousine receives a certificate of public convenience and necessity ("CPCN") from the Nevada Transportation Authority (the "Authority"), LVS LLC will continue to use the two Rolls Royce limousines to provide complimentary transportation services to certain customers, guests, casino hosts, key employees, officers and directors of The Venetian and The Palazzo under NRS 706.741.

¹ Venetian Casino Resort, LLC ("VCR") owns The Venetian and The Palazzo, which constitute a single resort hotel within the meaning of NRS 463.01865. LVS, the casino licensee, operates The Venetian and The Palazzo pursuant to a lease between LVS LLC and VCR.

Exhibit B

Venetian Limousine requests a CPCN authorizing it to operate as a common motor carrier. Venetian Limousine proposes to provide on-call, point-to-point service over irregular routes within Clark County. Specifically, Venetian Limousine proposes to provide the following services:

A. Transportation of customers, guests and patrons of the Properties and their baggage in limousines by prearranged charter order pursuant to which the customer, guest or patron pays Venetian Limousine for such service, either directly or indirectly; and,

B. Transportation of customers, guests and patrons of the Properties and their baggage in limousines by a prearranged charter order pursuant to which LVS LLC or VCR pays for the service through an inter-company charge.

Venetian Limousine will stage its vehicles and provide transportation service on a walk-up basis at the Properties. The Properties, however, are the only locations at which Venetian Limousine will stage its vehicles and provide service on a walk-up basis.

Based on the types of transportation services frequently requested by Venetian guests and patrons, Venetian Limousine anticipates that it would provide approximately 200,000 passenger trips annually. Approximately 80 percent of those trips will originate at the Properties and terminate at McCarran International Airport, or vice-versa. Another 12 to 15 percent of the passenger trips likely would originate at either one of the Properties and terminate at another location on Las Vegas Boulevard, or vice-versa. Finally, the remaining five to eight percent of projected passenger trips likely would originate at either of the Properties and terminate at restaurants, golf courses or other tourist attractions in Clark County, or vice-versa.

Exhibit C

Venetian Limousine requests permission to operate as a common motor carrier of passengers and their baggage. Specifically, Venetian Limousine seeks a CPCN pursuant to NRS 706.391 and Section 706.1375 of the Nevada Administrative Code ("NAC"). In addition, Venetian Limousine requests permission to provide charter service by limousine pursuant to NAC 706 353.

Exhibit E

Geographic Area to be Served

Venetian Limousine proposes to provide transportation services from any point within Clark County to another point within Clark County over irregular routes located entirely within Clark County. See Exhibit B for projections of most likely routes.

Equipment Location

Venetian Limousine will store its fleet at one of two locations. The first location is the second floor of the attached parking garage located at The Venetian. The physical address of this location is 3355 Las Vegas Boulevard South, Las Vegas, Nevada 89109. The second location is the second level of the underground parking garage located at The Palazzo which is located at 3325 Las Vegas Boulevard South, Las Vegas, Nevada 89109.

Terminal Location

Venetian Limousine will not operate a specific terminal. Venetian Limousine will have space at which it may stage vehicles, pick-up and drop-off customers within (a) the porte cochere at The Venetian, which is adjacent to Las Vegas Boulevard, (b) the porte cochere at The Palazzo, which is adjacent to Las Vegas Boulevard, and (c) the entrance to the Sands Exposition and Convention Center, which is adjacent to Sands Avenue.

Guests and patrons of the Properties will have several options for obtaining transportation services. First, Venetian Limousine will stage vehicles and provide service on a walk-up basis at the properties. Second, Guests and patrons of the Properties may request transportation services at (a) concierge desks located within The Venetian, The Palazzo and The Venezia lobby,² and (b) valet desks within The Venetian and The Palazzo. Third, The Venetian Resort Services call center will arrange for transportation service. Guests and patrons, consequently, will be able to arrange for transportation services from their hotel room and when they make a room reservation.

Narrative Description of Proposed Routes

Venetian Limousine does not propose to serve any specific routes; instead, Venetian Limousine proposes to provide point-to-point service from locations within Clark County to termination points within Clark County, based on the needs of the Properties' guests and patrons. As noted in the operating procedures for chauffeurs, see Exhibit K(1), drivers will be responsible for selecting the most efficient routes based on the needs of the Properties' guests and patrons and current traffic conditions.
