## CIRCUMSTANCES OF ARREST

On 5-17-08 Patrol Officer Fama, #88420 was dispatched to Summerlin Hospital at 657 Town Center Dr. reference a battery with a deadly weapon call. Officer Fama contacted the victim, Paul Maineri, in the emergency room who told him that his wife of one and one half months, Frances Allen, and he were in an altercation at their residence, 8708 Redbrook Dr., #104.

He stated that they had friends over from 7 p.m. to midnight on 5-15-08 and after they left they argued because she said that he had embarrassed her in front of their friends.

While arguing on the couch Allen began pushing his forehead and caused a small scratch on his forehead with her wedding ring. They continued to argue and went into the kitchen. As the argument escalated he said he got very close to Allen and she then took a steak knife from the butcher's block with her right hand and stabbed him one time in the left forearm.

Allen then went to their bedroom and locked the door. Maineri then pulled the knife out of his arm and put it on the kitchen floor. He walked to the bedroom door and found that it was locked so he pushed it with his shoulder and forced his way in. He asked Allen for help, but she refused and told him to call his mother. Allen then left the residence and Maineri picked up the knife used in the stabbing and put it into a clear zip-lock baggie and put it in his car that he drove to Summerlin Hospital. Maineri later signed a consent card for his car and Criminalistics recovered the knife and impounded it as evidence. The car was later impounded as evidence by Det. Raye. Maineri then drove himself to Summerlin Hospital Emergency. He also told Fama that he'd had one glass of champagne the night before and Allen had drunk red wine.

Upon receiving treatment at Summerlin Emergency, Maineri told Doctor Randall Miller that he had been stabbed "by his wife". Maineri received three stitches to the wound on his left forearm. Medical personnel notified Metro Police and Officer Fama was dispatched as stated above.

On 5-17-08 at about 0815 hours Officer Fama called Sergeant P. Miller of the Domestic Violence Detail and requested our assistance. Detective D. Raye, #3389, went to the scene at 8708 Redbrook Dr., #104. Sgt. Miller and Det. R. Schmidt, #3389, went to Summerlin and talked to Maineri.

Officers Radmanovich, #88420 and Dittmar, #88405 first contacted Allen at her residence and told Det. Raye that they read her the Miranda Warning at 0850 hours and that she told them she understood her rights. Allen told Officers Radmanovich and Dittmar that when she walked outside to her car at sunrise to leave that he had come outside also and had grabbed her as they continued to argue. She then went back inside with Maineri as they argued and he then cut himself on the arm with the knife and she picked up the phone and told him to call whoever he wanted to and then she left.

After Det. Raye arrived suspect Allen told him and Officers Radmanovich, #88420, and Dittmar, #88405 that they had a party on the 16<sup>th</sup> of May and that all had been drinking and playing games. About midnight their friends left and he and Maineri got into an argument over him not being able to get on her computer because he couldn't remember the password. She then logged him, but they continued to argue and then she left in her car about sunrise in order to go to the post office. She went and got her mail at her post office box and came back and checked her mail box at the condo and then came back to the house and found that Maineri was gone. She said that she then went to sleep until Officers woke her up. Det. Raye asked Allen if she had seen any injuries on Maineri and she said no.

Det. Raye then asked her how Maineri got injured since he was at the hospital with a stab wound and she replied that they had gotten into an argument and he had done it himself. She said he was in the kitchen and she was somewhere else in the house, unknown exactly where, and he cut himself. Det. Raye asked her about the red stains on floor of the kitchen and she said it was blood and that she had cleaned up the broken glass which had occurred a couple of hours before the "incident". Raye asked if it was his blood or her blood and she said it was his blood. Raye asked if she had cut herself in any way with the glass or otherwise and she said no, it was Maineri's blood. Allen refused to give a written or taped statement, but gave verbal and written consent for criminalistics to process the scene. The consent card was later impounded by Det. Raye.

Det. Raye did not observe any injuries on Allen at all and asked her if she had any and she said no. Allen also did not mention anything about being attacked by Maineri or being the victim of any other crime.

Det. Schmidt and Sergeant Miller contacted Maineri at Summerlin Hospital who told us that he and Allen had argued and at one point Maineri "got too close" to Allen and she "was just trying to make a point" and she "accidentally" stabbed him. Maineri was adamant the he did not want to get her in trouble and that he had been to jail and jail is a very bad place. When asked why he brought the knife used in the stabbing to the hospital with him he said, "It seemed like a good idea at the time" and maybe the doctor would want to see it. Maineri also told us that after the incident Allen left their residence and he drove himself to the hospital. Maineri refused to give a written or taped statement to Det. Schmidt and Miller, but later, after finding out that Allen was going to be arrested, said that he wanted to recant his story and give a taped statement now in which he would say that he stabbed himself if it would keep her from getting arrested.

Due to the above details Allen was placed under arrest by Det. Raye and transported to C.C.D.C. by Officer M. Casper, #8540, and booked for Battery With a Deadly Weapon - Domestic Violence for stabbing Maineri and Battery -DV for pushing his forehead and causing the scratch.

The above occurred in the City of Las Vegas, County of Clark, State of Nevada.
