Dear Mr. Maxfield:

This office represents M Resort Spa and Casino. Prior to the commencement of our hotel development, our client was required to pay certain connection fees to the City of Henderson. At the time of that payment, our client was advised that in excess of \$700,000 of those connection fees was to go to the Clean Water Coalition. This nearly three quarters of a million dollars was intended for the clear and specific purposes of the Clean Water Coalition. We have been informed that all, or a significant portion, of the monies deposited with the Clean Water Coalition are now sought to be taken by the State of Nevada and used to reduce the budget shortfall. However, this money was never intended to be used for any other purpose; and no one was or is authorized to use that money except for the specific purpose for which that payment was made.

Please be advised that our client does not consent, and will not accept, that those funds can be used for any purpose other than for the specific purpose for which they were intended. If the monies our client essentially paid into the Clean Water Coalition are not to be retained by the Clean Water Coalition and used for the specific purpose for which they were extracted, then those moneys should be returned to our client. It is not right, nor fair, nor in our opinion, legal, to extract fees from M Resort Spa and Casino for a particular stated purpose and then unilaterally change the purpose for which those monies were paid.

The purpose of this letter is to put all on notice that if these monies are in fact used for any other purpose than for the expressly stated purpose of the Clean Water Coalition, our client

will be constrained to file appropriate action to have those fees returned to M Resort Spa and Casino.
