On 050110, at approximately 0320 hours, Officer Smyly and I were doubled as two-officer team. We were dispatched to the Randolph Center, located at 1877 Broadway, with his a parking garage. We were advised that a male was standing near his vehicle, which had been broken into.

Upon arrival, I contacted Joseph Benedetto, who was on the phone attempting to cancel is Visa card. Benedetto told me that he parked his vehicle in the structure, in the first parking space (non-handicap) on the south side of the first level, just west of the entrance to the parking structure, at approximately 2150 hours.

As he left his vehicle, he locked the doors and heard the doors beep to notify him that they were locked.

When he returned to the car at approximately 0320 hours, he observed that the interior dome lights were on and the driver's side door was slightly ajar.

Upon further inspection of the vehicle, he noticed that his Glock 36 handgun was missing from the glove compartment. The gun was kept in the unlocked compartment and was loaded.

Also missing was Benedetto's wallet, which he kept in the center console in the vehicle. Missing from the wallet is Benedetto's Colorado Driver's License (02-087-0899), is Colorado Concealed Weapon Permit, a Visa Credit Card from Bellco Bank, and a Visa check card.

Benedetto purchased dog food earlier in the day, prior to parking his car in the garage. The dog food had been removed from the store bag (which was on the back seat) and was opened, placed in the front seat of the car.

Benedetto entered the vehicle and opened all doors prior to my arrival. He stated that only the above items of value were missing.

Benedetto told me that only his family members know that he carries and leaves his loaded handgun in his vehicle, however when asked by another officer, he advised that a "couple" people that he works with know about the gun. He was adamant that he locked the car before going into work.

After checking the car, I was unable to locate any sign or point of entry. The window and window seals were all in place and did not have any damage. Benedetto told me that he is the only person with access to the car keys.

Benedetto was able to cancel his credit and check card. He did not have the serial number for the gun, but advised that he would contact me with the information.

I provided Benedetto with my business card and the case number.

I then began dusting for latent fingerprints. I was able to develop prints on the door handle (which was handled by Benedetto), the top of the drivers side door, the interior dome light, and the bag of dog food. I lifted the prints and placed the latent fingerprint cards into Property and Evidence at the Boulder Police Department.

There is no further information.

On 05/01/10 at approximately 1028 hours Boulder PD dispatch requested that I return a phone call to a previous victim, Joseph Benedetto, since he had more information to relay. I contacted him by phone and he stated he was the victim of a previously reported vehicle trespass and had subsequent contact with the suspect this morning.

Benedetto had filed a criminal trespass to his vehicle report on 05/01/10 at approximately 0320 hours, where his vehicle had been unlawfully entered and a .45 caliber handgun, wallet with contents, and several other miscellaneous items had been stolen. He said that after filing the report he returned home to 921 W. 100th Ave in Northglenn where he remained until he was awoken at approximately 0940 hours by persistent knocking on his door. He said he observed a white male in his thirties at his door and did not initially answer the door since he believed it to be a sales person. He stated that the male continued to be persistent in his knocking for a total of

approximately three minutes and he then opened the door to him. Upon opening the door he observed a white male, approximately 30 years of age, 6'01" to 6'03", approx 240 lbs, light sandy brown hair in a short crew cut style, and wearing blue jeans, brown sandals, and a teal colored v neck t-shirt.

Benedetto works as a doorman at Club Nitro in Boulder and recognized the male as someone who he had turned away at the club at approximately 0001 hours on 05/01/10 for being too intoxicated to enter. He said that the male had been stumbling and swaying as he walked eastbound towards him down the alley. Benedetto said that he stopped close to him and appeared to be speaking with him but that his speech was mostly mumbling and unintelligible due to apparent intoxication. Benedetto told him he was too intoxicated to come into the club and the male continued walking eastbound with no further interaction. Benedetto said that he was positive that it was the same male at the club and his residence. He was sure of this since his appearance was identical and he was still in the same aforementioned clothes from the contact several hours before.

Upon opening his front door, the male at his doorstep stated, "Hey I'm sorry, I was really drunk last night. I think I was drugged. I'd like to give you your stuff back, Here it is." He then pointed to the doorstep between them where Benedetto observed his handgun (and other misc items that had been stolen from his car) was now laying. He then went on to state, "I was really drunk, I'm from out of town, I'm just here visiting friends, I'm a professional, I don't do this kind of stuff." Benedetto said the male then offered his hand to shake it and upon doing so he observed that the male was not wearing any gloves. The male then entered his car parked in front of the residence and began to drive away. Benedetto described the car as a new white Ford four door sedan with a portable GPS stuck in the front window Lic #081UAN. He then retrieved the items from the doorstep called 911 and got into his own vehicle and began to follow the other car. His 911 call was connected to Westminster PD and he was informed that due to their call load they had no Officer's available for immediate assistance. I confirmed this information through Westminster PD and they stated they received his 911 call at 0945 hours and that his stated location at that time was 104th and Federal. Benedetto said that he was sure of the plate number and that it was a white Colorado plate. After being informed by Westminster PD that Officers were unavailable to assist him he discontinued following the vehicle and then subsequently called the Boulder PD non emergency line to pass on the aforementioned information.

He told me by phone that when he retrieved his items from the porch he did so with a minimal amount of contact to preserve any evidence the male might have left on them. I requested that Benedetto drive to the Boulder Police Department to meet with me and to bring the items with him. He agreed to this and I met him at approximately 1109 hours where he turned the items (see property for details) over for processing and completed an interview with me. Benedetto confirmed his previously provided information and said that he believed the male was the same person who had entered his car and that he was from out of town. He said he reached these conclusions due to his statements and that the car appeared to be a new fleet vehicle with a GPS in the window, consistent with a rental car.

I requested that Boulder PD dispatch run the provide plate number of the suspect vehicle and a clearance came back to a 2010 white Ford sedan owned by Hertz rental company. Follow up with Hertz determined that the vehicle was currently under rental contract to Tyler Gregorak from Montana with a contact number of 702 895 3459 with a return due date of May 5th, 2010. I attempted contact with the phone several times but was only able to reach the voice mail identifying the owner as Tyler Gregorak, offensive line coach and recruiting coordinator for the University of Nevada, Las Vegas (UNLV) football team. I confirmed that this information was accurate on the UNLV website and a clearance of his information with Boulder PD records provided the following description, white male, 6'03, 265lbs, Sandy hair, Blue eyes. This information matched the suspect description provided by Benedetto. Gregorak had a driver's license out of Montana that is currently under revocation for a conviction on original charges of driving while ability impaired 03/19/2010. Gregorak had a previous local address of 2650 Dartmouth ave, Boulder CO from 09/2001 and a check with CUPD indicated that he had previously been a athletic intern and student. UNLV's website stated that Gregorak had been a coach at the University of Montana for the previous 7 years prior to joining their staff this year. A records check confirmed this with a previous Montana address and a current Nevada address.

I advised patrol and detective supervisors of the contents of this report, forwarded it to the detectives bureau for continued investigation and entered the returned property into Boulder PD Property and Evidence for potential evidence processing. There was no need to remove the firearm from CCIC/NCIC since it had not been entered originally due to an unknown serial number. Based on the information contained in this and the original report the following additional charges may apply:

Mr. Benedetto stated that the person shown in picture #3 was the same person he had seen at Club Nitro. Mr. Benedetto also stated that the person in #3 was the same person who had been at his home giving him back his stolen items. I asked how certain he was that the person in #3 was the suspect and Mr. Benedetto said he was positive and wrote 100% and initialled next to a circled #3 on the line-up.

Mr. Benedetto's vehicle is a white 4 door Nissan Sentra with tinted windows. I noted that the vehicle that Mr. Gregorak had rented was a white Ford 4 door sedan.

After speaking to Mr. Benedetto and his positive identification of Mr. Gregorak, I wrote an arrest warrant affidavit and face sheet and will be applying for an arrest warrant for First Degree Criminal Trespass and Prohibited Use of Weapons.



On 050110, at approximately 0320 hours, Officer Smyly and I were doubled as two-officer team. We were dispatched to the Randolph Center, located at 1877 Broadway, with his a parking garage. We were advised that a male was standing near his vehicle, which had been broken into.

Upon arrival, I contacted Joseph Benedetto, who was on the phone attempting to cancel is Visa card. Benedetto told me that he parked his vehicle in the structure, in the first parking space (non-handicap) on the south side of the first level, just west of the entrance to the parking structure, at approximately 2150 hours.

As he left his vehicle, he locked the doors and heard the doors beep to notify him that they were locked.

When he returned to the car at approximately 0320 hours, he observed that the interior dome lights were on and the driver's side door was slightly ajar.

Upon further inspection of the vehicle, he noticed that his Glock 36 handgun was missing from the glove compartment. The gun was kept in the unlocked compartment and was loaded.

Also missing was Benedetto's wallet, which he kept in the center console in the vehicle. Missing from the wallet is Benedetto's Colorado Driver's License (02-087-0899), is Colorado Concealed Weapon Permit, a Visa Credit Card from Bellco Bank, and a Visa check card.

Benedetto purchased dog food earlier in the day, prior to parking his car in the garage. The dog food had been removed from the store bag (which was on the back seat) and was opened, placed in the front seat of the car.

Benedetto entered the vehicle and opened all doors prior to my arrival. He stated that only the above items of value were missing.

Benedetto told me that only his family members know that he carries and leaves his loaded handgun in his vehicle, however when asked by another officer, he advised that a "couple" people that he works with know about the gun. He was adamant that the locked the car before going into work.

After checking the car, I was unable to locate any sign or point of entry. The window and window seals were all in place and did not have any damage. Benedetto told me that he is the only person with access to the car keys.

Benedetto was able to cancel his credit and check card. He did not have the serial number for the gun, but advised that he would contact me with the information.

I provided Benedetto with my business card and the case number.

I then began dusting for latent fingerprints. I was able to develop prints on the door handle (which was handled by Benedetto), the top of the drivers side door, the interior dome light, and the bag of dog food. I lifted the prints and placed the latent fingerprint cards into Property and Evidence at the Boulder Police Department.

There is no further information.

On 05/01/10 at approximately 1028 hours Boulder PD dispatch requested that I return a phone call to a previous victim, Joseph Benedetto, since he had more information to relay. I contacted him by phone and he stated he was the victim of a previously reported vehicle trespass and had subsequent contact with the suspect this morning.

Benedetto had filed a criminal trespass to his vehicle report on 05/01/10 at approximately 0320 hours, where his vehicle had been unlawfully entered and a .45 caliber handgun, wallet with contents, and several other miscellaneous items had been stolen. He said that after filing the report he returned home to 921 W. 100th Ave in Northglenn where he remained until he was awoken at approximately 0940 hours by persistent knocking on his door. He said he observed a white male in his thirties at his door and did not initially answer the door since he believed it to be a sales person. He stated that the male continued to be persistent in his knocking for a total of

approximately three minutes and he then opened the door to him. Upon opening the door he observed a white male, approximately 30 years of age, 6'01" to 6'03", approx 240 lbs, light sandy brown hair in a short crew cut style, and wearing blue jeans, brown sandals, and a teal colored v neck t-shirt.

Benedetto works as a doorman at Club Nitro in Boulder and recognized the male as someone who he had turned away at the club at approximately 0001 hours on 05/01/10 for being too intoxicated to enter. He said that the male had been stumbling and swaying as he walked eastbound towards him down the alley. Benedetto said that he stopped close to him and appeared to be speaking with him but that his speech was mostly mumbling and unintelligible due to apparent intoxication. Benedetto told him he was to intoxicated to come into the club and the male continued walking eastbound with no further interaction. Benedetto said that he was positive that it was the same male at the club and his residence. He was sure of this since his appearance was identical and he was still in the same aforementioned clothes from the contact several hours before.

Upon opening his front door, the male at his doorstep stated, "Hey I'm sorry, I was really drunk last night. I think I was drugged. I'd like to give you your stuff back, Here it is." He then pointed to the doorstep between them where Benedetto observed his handgun (and other misc items that had been stolen from his car) was now laying. He then went on to state, "I was really drunk, I'm from out of town, I'm just here visiting friends, I'm a professional, I don't do this kind of stuff." Benedetto said the male then offered his hand to shake it and upon doing so he observed that the male was not wearing any gloves. The male then entered his car parked in front of the residence and began to drive away. Benedetto described the car as a new white Ford four door sedan with a portable GPS stuck in the front window Lic #081UAN. He then retrieved the items from the doorstep called 911 and got into his own vehicle and began to follow the other car. His 911 call was connected to Westminster PD and he was informed that due to their call load they had no Officer's available for immediate assistance. I confirmed this information through Westminster PD and they stated they received his 911 call at 0945 hours and that his stated location at that time was 104th and Federal. Benedetto said that he was sure of the plate number and that it was a white Colorado plate. After being informed by Westminster PD that Officers were unavailable to assist him he discontinued following the vehicle and then subsequently called the Boulder PD non emergency line to pass on the aforementioned information.

He told me by phone that when he retrieved his items from the porch he did so with a minimal amount of contact to preserve any evidence the male might have left on them. I requested that Benedetto drive to the Boulder Police Department to meet with me and to bring the items with him. He agreed to this and I met him at approximately 1109 hours where he turned the items (see property for details) over for processing and completed an interview with me. Benedetto confirmed his previously provided information and said that he believed the male was the same person who had entered his car and that he was from out of town. He said he reached these conclusions due to his statements and that the car appeared to be a new fleet vehicle with a GPS in the window, consistent with a rental car.

I requested that Boulder PD dispatch run the provide plate number of the suspect vehicle and a clearance came back to a 2010 white Ford sedan owned by Hertz rental company. Follow up with Hertz determined that the vehicle was currently under rental contract to Tyler Gregorak from Montana with a contact number of 702 895 3459 with a return due date of May 5th, 2010. I attempted contact with the phone several times but was only able to reach the voice mail identifying the owner as Tyler Gregorak, offensive line coach and recruiting coordinator for the University of Nevada, Las Vegas (UNLV) football team. I confirmed that this information was accurate on the UNLV website and a clearance of his information with Boulder PD records provided the following description, white male, 603, 265lbs, Sandy hair, Blue eyes. This information matched the suspect description provided by Benedetto. Gregorak had a driver's license out of Montana that is currently under revocation for a conviction on original charges of driving while ability impaired 03/19/2010. Gregorak had a previous local address of 2650 Dartmouth ave, Boulder CO from 09/2001 and a check with CUPD indicated that he had previously been a athletic intern and student. UNLV's website stated that Gregorak had been a coach at the University of Montana for the previous 7 years prior to joining their staff this year. A records check confirmed this with a previous Montana address and a current Nevada address.

I advised patrol and detective supervisors of the contents of this report, forwarded it to the detectives bureau for continued investigation and entered the returned property into Boulder PD Property and Evidence for potential evidence processing. There was no need to remove the firearm from CCIC/NCIC since it had not been entered originally due to an unknown serial number. Based on the information contained in this and the original report the following additional charges may apply:

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Prohibited use of a weapon (possession while intoxicated at the time of the theft)
Driving while under revocation (suspended DUI conviction)
Probation violations (No alcohol, no driving, no DL violations)

I showed the line-up to Mr. Benedetto who immediately said, "I see him, he is right there" He pointed to the person pictured in photograph #3. Mr. Benedetto stated that the person shown in picture #3 was the same person he had seen at Club Nitro. Mr. Benedetto also stated that the person in #3 was the same person who had been at his home giving him back his stolen items. I asked how certain he was that the person in #3 was the suspect and Mr. Benedetto said he was positive and wrote 100% and initialled next to a circled #3 on the line-up.

After speaking to Mr. Benedetto and his positive identification of Mr. Gregorak, I wrote an arrest warrant affidavit and face sheet and will be applying for an arrest warrant for First Degree Criminal Trespass and Prohibited Use of Weapons.

On 05/04/10, I obtained an arrest warrant for Mr. Gregorak. I then called University of Northern Las Vegas Police Department asking for assistance in getting in touch with Mr. Gregorak. I was given a cellular phone number for Mr. Gregorak that he had called in to the UNLV Police Department with shortly after my initial call to them for assistance.

I was able to make contact with Mr. Gregorak and had a phone conversation with him. During the conversation with Mr. Gregorak, I asked if he knew why I might be trying to contact him and he acknowledged that he was aware of the situation. Mr. Gregorak told me that he does not know what happened, or how he ended up with Mr. Benedetto's belongings. Mr. Gregorak stated that he and some friends had been out visiting bars in downtown Boulder. Mr. Gregorak stated that he remembers going to the Lazy Dog Bar and another bar that was located down a set of stairs. He described it as a dive bar. He said that he does not remember anything after that.

Mr. Gregorak stated that he woke up at his hotel and he saw the gun and Mr. Benedetto's other belongings. He was unsure how he ended up with them. Mr. Gregorak asked how he could have gotten in to the car without breaking entry. Mr. Gregorak indicated that he did not remember having any sort of confrontation with Mr.

Benedetto. Mr. Gregorak stated that he initially tried to call 411 to locate a phone number for Mr. Benedetto but was unsuccessful in contacting him that way. Mr. Gregorak then used his GPS navigation device to locate Mr. Benedetto's residence. Mr. Gregorak stated that he drove out to Mr. Benedetto's residence to return the items to him and to try to learn how he ended up with them in his possession.

During our conversation, Mr. Gregorak did remember that the name of the person's belongings he had returned was Joe Benedetto. I told Mr. Gregorak that he was not to have any contact with Mr. Benedetto. Mr. Gregorak acknowledged that he could not have contact with Mr. Benedetto. I asked a couple of times for names of people that he had been with, but Mr. Gregorak did not provide them to me. I explained that it would be helpful for me to be able to speak with them to try to learn more about what happened that night.

I told Mr. Gregorak that I believed that the best course of action for him was to turn himself in. Mr. Gregorak stated that he was going to call his Father to make arrangements to do so.

During the phone call, Mr. Gregorak expressed concern that he could not remember what had happened or how he had ended up with Mr. Benedetto's belongings. At one point, he stated that it was as if someone had slipped him a drug or something similar. Mr. Gregorak stated that he was concerned about the arrest process, I explained the process to him as best I could. I told Mr. Gregorak that he could turn himself in to me directly, to the Jail, or another officer. I told him that he would be treated with respect so he did not have to worry about being mistreated. He said that he was not worried about that, but was extremely concerned about his employment status and that the situation occurred at all. I was able to digitally record my conversation with Mr. Gregorak and placed a CD-R containing the recording in to property and evidence.


Through various phone conversations with Mr. Gregorak and then one with his attorney, Mr. Gregorak determined that he would turn himself in at the Boulder County Jail. I called Mr. Benedetto and informed him about the pending arrest. On 05/05/10 at approximately 0730 Hours, I confirmed that Mr. Benedetto had voluntarily turned himself in at the Boulder County Jail. This case is cleared with an arrest.

On the morning of Saturday May 1, 2010 I was awoken by knocking at my door. I looked out my bedroom window and saw a man that I did not know. I didn't initially answer the door because I assumed he was a solicitor. The man kept knocking and pounding on my door. I answered the door. "Hey, um.... im really sorry about last night and I wanted to bring you your stuff back." I said, what? He replied, "I'm really sorry. This is your stuff right? (He pointed to the landing between us and I saw, on the ground, the items stolen from my car) I saw my handgun, wallet, phone charger, cologne, sunglasses, pocketknife, insurance card, and other miscellaneous items. He picked up my wallet and pointed to my drivers license. "This is you right? This is your address? I'm sorry. Last night I was really drunk. I'm not from here. I'm in town visiting friends. I don't do these kind of things." We shook hands. I picked up my stuff. (During our interaction I didn't say much. I was completely stunned by what was happening.) I placed the items on my sofa. Then I ran out the backdoor and leaped over the fence and ran to the sidewalk, trying to look at his license plate. He was driving down the street and I couldn't see it. I ran back into the house and into my bedroom. I quickly put my shoes on and grabbed my keys. I ran out the front door and got into my car. I hastily drove down the street and noticed the car about 10 blocks away. I caught up to him at a stop sign. There was a car between us. He turned left onto westbound 104th. I did the same. I got behind him, typed his license plate number into my phone and saved it. I then dialed 911. I told dispatch that I was following the man who broke into my car and stole my gun and my direction of travel. She asked, "Who had the gun." I said, I do. She transferred me to the Westminster police department. At this time he noticed I was following him. He made a right turn onto Newton st., then an immediate U-turn, and turned right, back onto 104th. I continued to follow. Then he turned right on Legacy Ridge Parkway, into the "Legacy Ridge" housing development. Westminster's dispatcher told me "we have no available units." I said, "You can't send anyone?" "No sir, all our units are tied up." He then signaled right and turned left. Knowing that the police couldn't help me I turned right, made a U-turn and went home. After arriving home, I called the Boulder police department and informed them of what happened.
