NOTES & HIGHLIGHTS:

With an improved convention month and strong drive-in traffic (+4.4%) offsetting a small decrease in air passenger counts(-0.4%), Las Vegas enjoyed its 12th straight monthly increase in visitor volume (+3.5%) as the destination hosted more than 3.2 million visitors.

As a few tradeshows were scheduled in August this year vs. different months last year, Las Vegas saw a +46.3% increase in convention attendance compared to August 2009; two notable larger shows that fell in August instead of September this year were MAGIC (75,000 attendees) and World Marker Center's semiannual event (approx. 50,000 attendees).

Citywide occupancy showed an increase of +0.6 pts, the first year-over-year monthly increase since December 2007. Although below peak levels experienced prior to the economic slowdown, Average Daily Room Rates (ADR) showed continued improvement, exceeding \$87 (+4.0% vs. last August).

With lower visitor spending reflected in monthly declines in gross gaming revenue for much of 2010, Las Vegas welcomed an increase of +13.8% for Clark County while the Las Vegas Strip showed an increase of +21.1%. The increases were supported in part by notably high volume of baccarat play, a higher slot hold percentage and bleedover of winnings from the last weekend of July.
