9 The Defendant above named having committed the crimes of MURDER (Felony -
10 NRS 200.010, 200.030), BATTERY CONSTITUTING DOMESTIC VIOLENCE -
11 STRANGULATION (Felony - NRS 200.481; 200.485; 33.018), and DESTROYING
12 EVIDENCE (Gross Misdemeanor - NRS 199.220), in the manner following, to-wit: That
13 the said Defendant, on or about the 12th day of December, 2010, at and within the County of
14 Clark, State of Nevada,

15 COUNT 1 - MURDER

16 did then and there wilfully, feloniously, without authority of law, and with
17 premeditation and deliberation, and with malice aforethought, kill DEBORAH FLORES-
18 NARVAEZ, a human being, by manner and means unknown.

19 COUNT 2 - BATTERY CONSTITUTING DOMESTIC VIOLENCE - STRANGULATION

20 did then and there wilfully, unlawfully, and feloniously use force or violence upon
21 the person of the defendant's spouse, former spouse, or any other person to whom the
22 defendant is related by blood or marriage, a person with whom the defendant is or was
23 actually residing, a person with whom the defendant is having a dating relationship, a person
24 with whom the defendant has a child in common, the minor child of any of those persons or
25 the defendant's minor child, to-wit: DEBORAH FLORES-NARVAEZ, by strangulation, by
26 putting both hands around the neck of the said DEBORAH FLORES-NARVAEZ and
27 restricting her ability to breathe.

1 COUNT 3 - DESTROYING EVIDENCE

2 did wilfully and unlawfully, with intent to conceal the commission of a felony, to-
3 wit: murder, or to protect or conceal the identity of any person committing the same, or with
4 the intent to delay or hinder the administration of the law, or to prevent the production
5 thereof at any time in any Court, or before any Officer, Tribunal, Judge, or Magistrate,
6 destroy evidence by purchasing tubs and cleaning supplies to hide the murder of DEBORAH
7 FLORES-NARVAEZ and any evidence of its occurrence. and using tools to dismember her
8 body to better conceal it and moving the tubs to various locations to conceal the location of
9 the body of the said DEBORAH FLORES-NARVAEZ.

10 All of which is contrary to the form, force and effect of Statutes in such cases made
11 and provided and against the peace and dignity of the State of Nevada. Said Complainant
12 makes this declaration subject to the penalty of perjury.
