DETAILS:

On March 19, 2011, at approximately 1645 hours, I, Officer S. Ferguson, P#8568, operating as plain clothes unit 8111, was patrolling the area of Lisbon and Cambridge, which is known to be a high area for narcotics sells and usage as well as violent crimes.

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While in the area, I observed a white, four-door BMW with Nevada plate 735TBA traveling eastbound on Lisbon roll down it's passenger window and come to a stop in front of 1017 Lisbon. The BMW, which was stopped halfway into the eastbound travel lane, had a black male adult approach the vehicle and got into the passenger side of the BMW. The black male adult came from the courtyard of 1017 Lisbon, which was the courtyard the BMW was parked out in front of. As I pulled passed the BMW, I observed a white male adult with reading glasses driving the BMW. Once the black male adult entered the vehicle, it completed a U-turn and drove west on Lisbon to Cambridge.

The vehicle then went south on Cambridge to Dumont where it turned east onto Dumont. The BMW pulled over in front of 1001 Dumont and came to a stop by the curb. Once the vehicle came to the stop, the black male adult on the passenger side then exited the vehicle and ran north across Dumont then to 1000 Dumont apartment complex. At that time, the vehicle, still driven by the white male adult with glasses, continued on Dumont at a slow pace in an eastern direction. The vehicle completed another U-turn and came to a stop on Dumont facing west. The vehicle stayed parked at the same location for approximately two minutes. The vehicle then pulled forward westbound on Dumont then parked again in front of 1000 Dumont for approximately two minutes until the black male adult returned to the vehicle. At that time, the black male adult entered back into the BMW and the vehicle started driving west on Dumont towards Cambridge.

The vehicle then turned north onto Cambridge without using a turn signal. I then conducted a vehicle stop on the BMW due to the fact that he did not use a turn signal to turn onto Cambridge. The vehicle stop was conducted on Cambridge northbound north of Dumont by activating my red and blue lights and siren. The vehicle pulled over. At which time, I advised the driver to turn off the vehicle. At that time, the passenger door opened and the black male adult exited and began to run north on Cambridge towards Sierra Vista. After a short foot pursuit, the suspect was taken into custody and was verbally identified as Raymond Streeter, date of birth 07/10/67. Officer T. Pandullo, P#7884, assisted me in taking Raymond into custody. After getting Raymond into custody, I advised over the radio for a second unit to go over to the location of the car stop and detain the driver of the BMW.

Officer D. Radich, P#9340, and Officer B. Clarkson, P#8890, responded to the car stop scene and took the driver into custody and conducted a consensual search. Officer D. Radich, P#9340, did not locate any type of evidence during his consensual search. The subject, who was driving the BMW was later identified as David Schubert, date of birth 09/27/63, via Clark County District Attorney ID card and a Nevada driver's license. A taped interview with conducted with Raymond Streeter at the scene. The interview was conducted with the assistance of Officer T. Pandullo, P#7884. During the interview, Raymond was read his rights per Miranda off Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department Miranda card. Raymond stated that he understood his rights and was willing to talk.

During the interview, Raymond stated that he knew the subject, we know as David, as Joe. He stated that Joe would come by the area three to four times a week and use Raymond to purchase \$40 worth of cocaine. Raymond was able to supply a cellular phone number for Joe off his personal cellular phone. He stated that Joe calls Raymond periodically to ask if anybody is selling narcotics. The number given by Raymond for Joe was 702-624-

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9924. Raymond went on to explain that Joe would pick him up and give him a ride to different locations within the area. Joe would then give him \$40 to enter different complexes where narcotics is sold to purchase cocaine. Raymond stated this particular incident, Joe gave him \$40 to purchase cocaine. Raymond also stated that Joe has been coming in the area for approximately six to seven months to purchase narcotics. During the investigation, I looked into the BMW through the windshield and could see what I believed to be a rock cocaine.

The white, rocklike substance was on the passenger floorboard where Raymond stated Joe threw the cocaine when stopped by the police. Due to the fact that at the time of the stop the vehicle was occupied and mobile and in plain view I could see a white, rocklike substance that based on my training and experience I believed to be cocaine, I then recovered the substance and tested it by using ODV test kit for cocaine. The substance tested positive for cocaine. It is to be noted that I was trained to test narcotics by using the ODV test kit in April of 2005. Sergeant S. Womack, P#4953, witnessed the positive outcome of the cocaine. Due to the facts and circumstances, David Schubert was arrested for conspiracy to violate the uniformed controlled substance act and possession of a controlled substance cocaine. David was then transported to Clark County Detention Center where he was booked accordingly.
