It appears that parties are now at impasse. Clark County hereby invokes the impasse procedure set out in NRS Chapter 288.


As we discussed, mediation would not likely result in a quick resolution. Therefore I suggest that we select a fact finder and schedule a hearing. If the parties wish to attempt mediation we can always agree to try that while awaiting the fact finding hearing date.

Pursuant to NRS 288.200, paragraph 5, "The parties to the dispute may agree, before the submission of the dispute to fact-finding, to make the findings and recommendations on all or any specified issues final and binding on the parties".

As we discussed, proceeding directly to binding fact finding is, under the circumstances, the best and most expedient method to achieve resolution. If you agree, please sign where indicated below and fax this letter to 702-868-2581 to my attention by the end of business on May 31, 2011. Once I receive your response, I will request a panel of neutrals from the FMCS pursuant to NRS 288.

If I do not receive a response by the end of business on May 31, 2011 I will request a panel of neutrals from the FMCS pursuant to NRS 288 for non-binding fact finding.
