

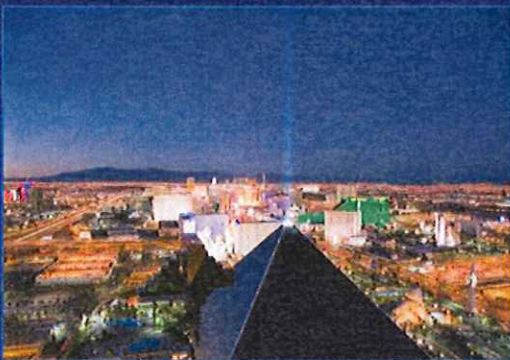

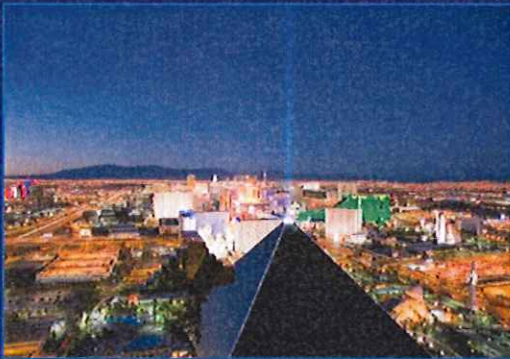

# Methodology

Public Opinion Strategies is pleased to present the key findings of a telephone survey conducted in Nevada's 4<sup>th</sup> Congressional District. The survey was completed November 30<sup>th</sup>- December 1st, 2011 among 328 likely GOP primary voters, with a margin of error of  $\pm 5.41\%$ .

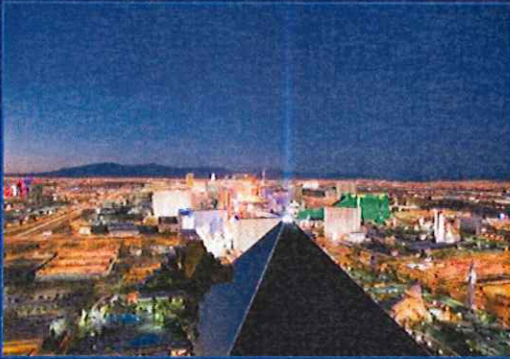

# Political Environment

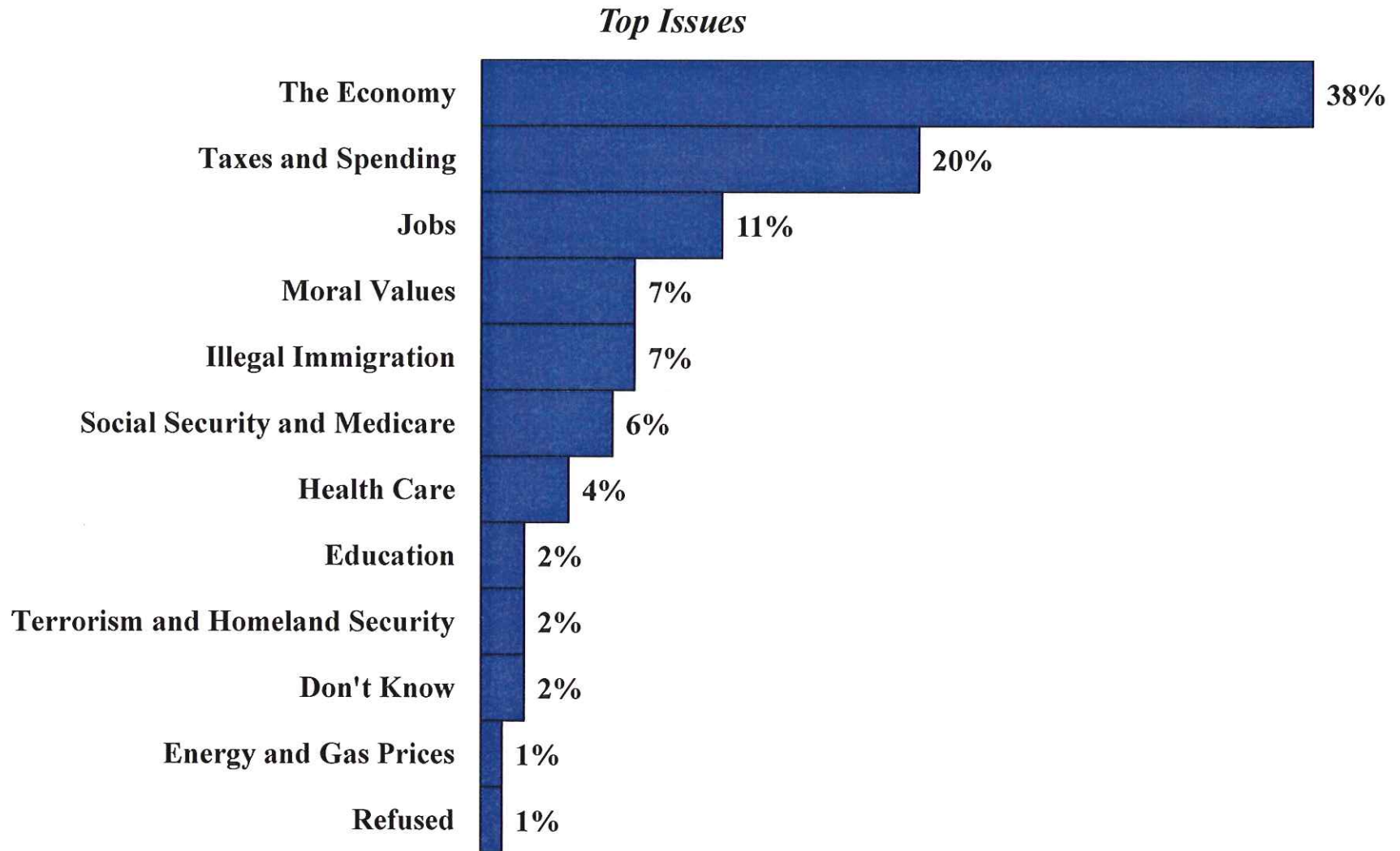
## Profile of GOP Primary Electorate

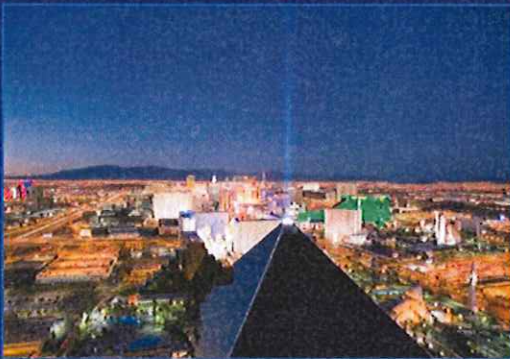
- **By core voters, 49% are base GOP/very conservative, 39% are base GOP/strongly favor Tea Party and 35% are base GOP/65+.**
- **By county, 83% are from Clark and 17% are from Lyon, Mineral, Nye or White Pine.**
- **The majority are from Las Vegas (58%), with 16% from North Las Vegas, 10% from Pahrump and 17% from other cities.**
- **By gender, 48% are men and 52% are women.**
- **The plurality (45%) are ages 65+. Seven percent (7%) are ages 18-34, 18% are 35-44, 13% are 45-54 and 18% are 55-64.**
- **By ideology, 53% are very conservative, 28% are somewhat conservative and 17% are moderate/liberal.**
- **By Tea Party image, 43% strongly favor the Tea Party, 22% somewhat favor the Tea Party, 10% are unfavorable and 24% don't know or have no opinion.**
- **By education, 20% have HS or less, 35% have some college, 30% are college graduates and 15% went to grad school.**

# Not surprisingly, the economy, taxes and spending are GOP primary voters' top concerns.

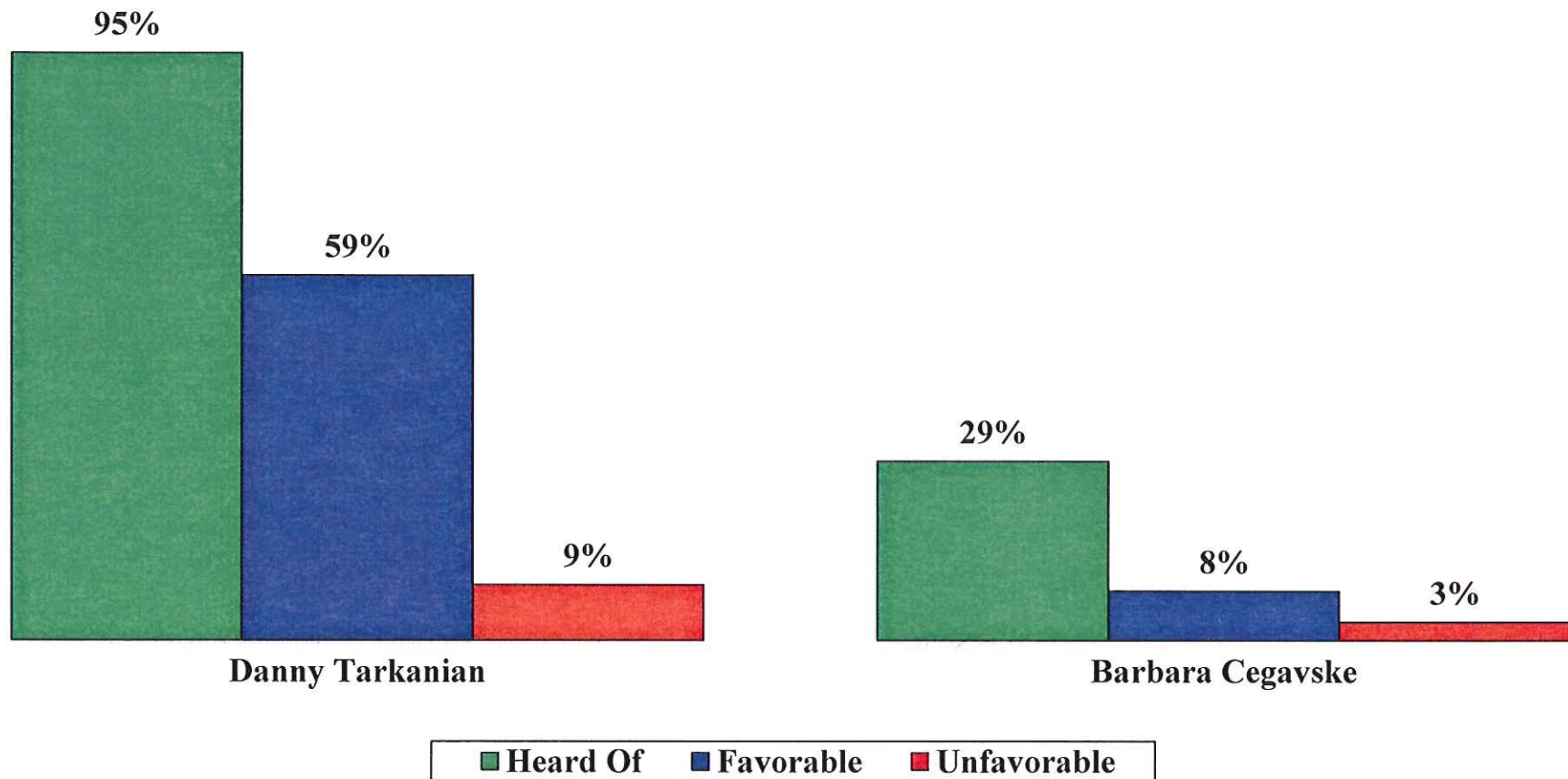

*Name ID and Image*

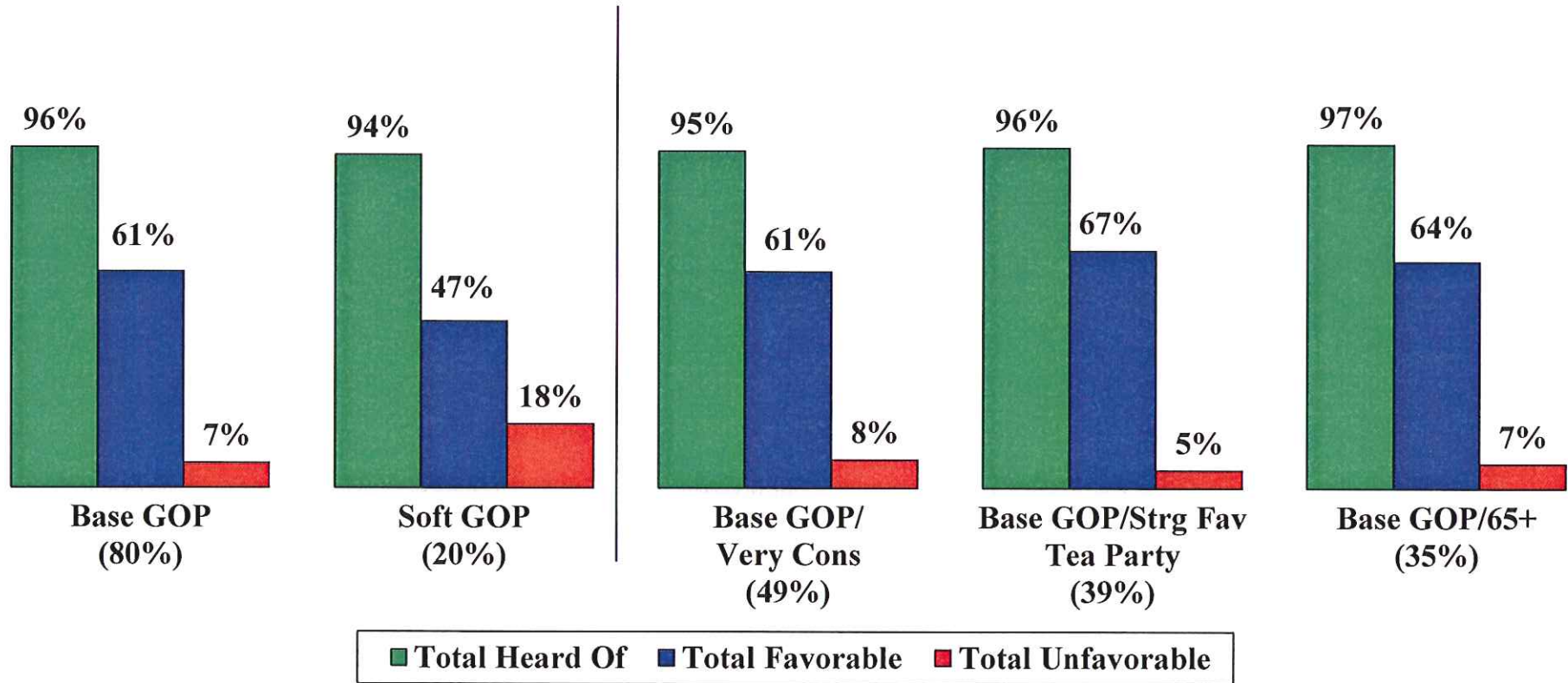

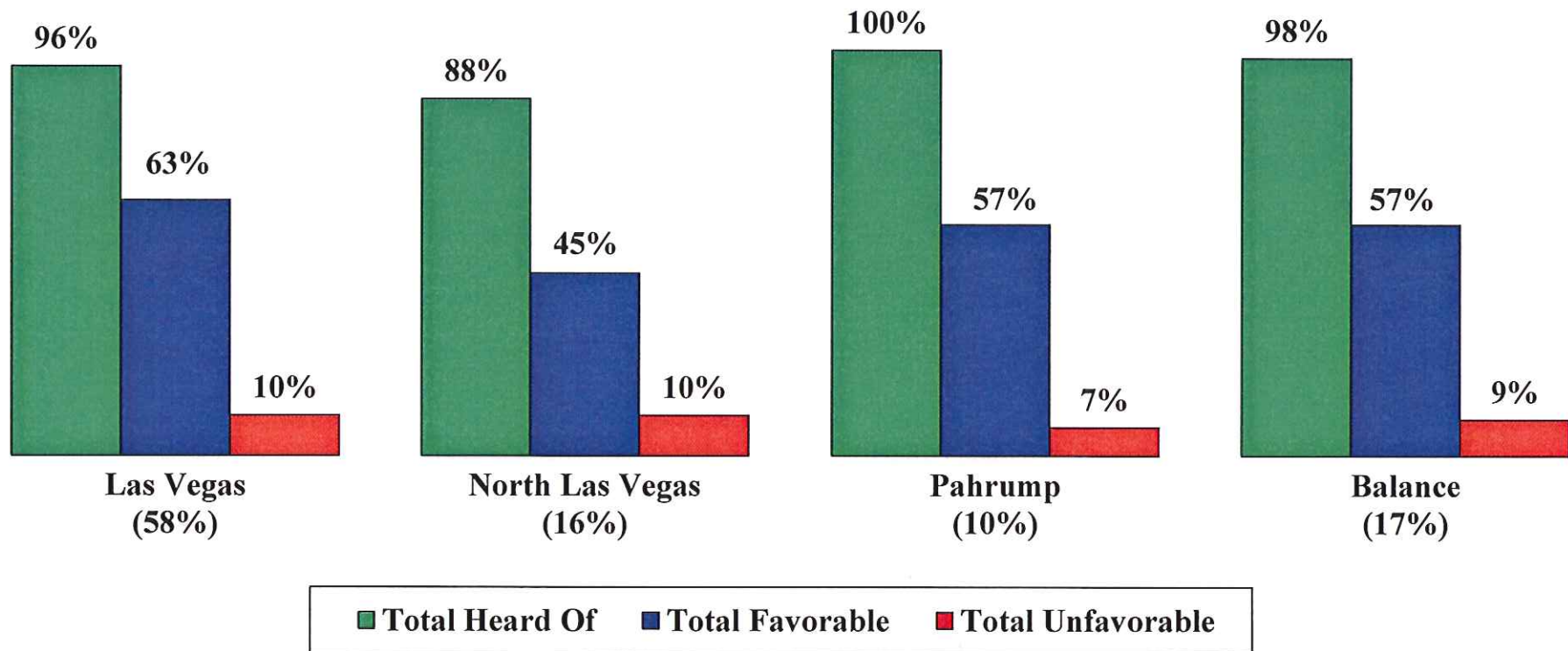
# Core GOP voters know Tarkanian and like him.

*Tarkanian ID/Image by Party/Core*



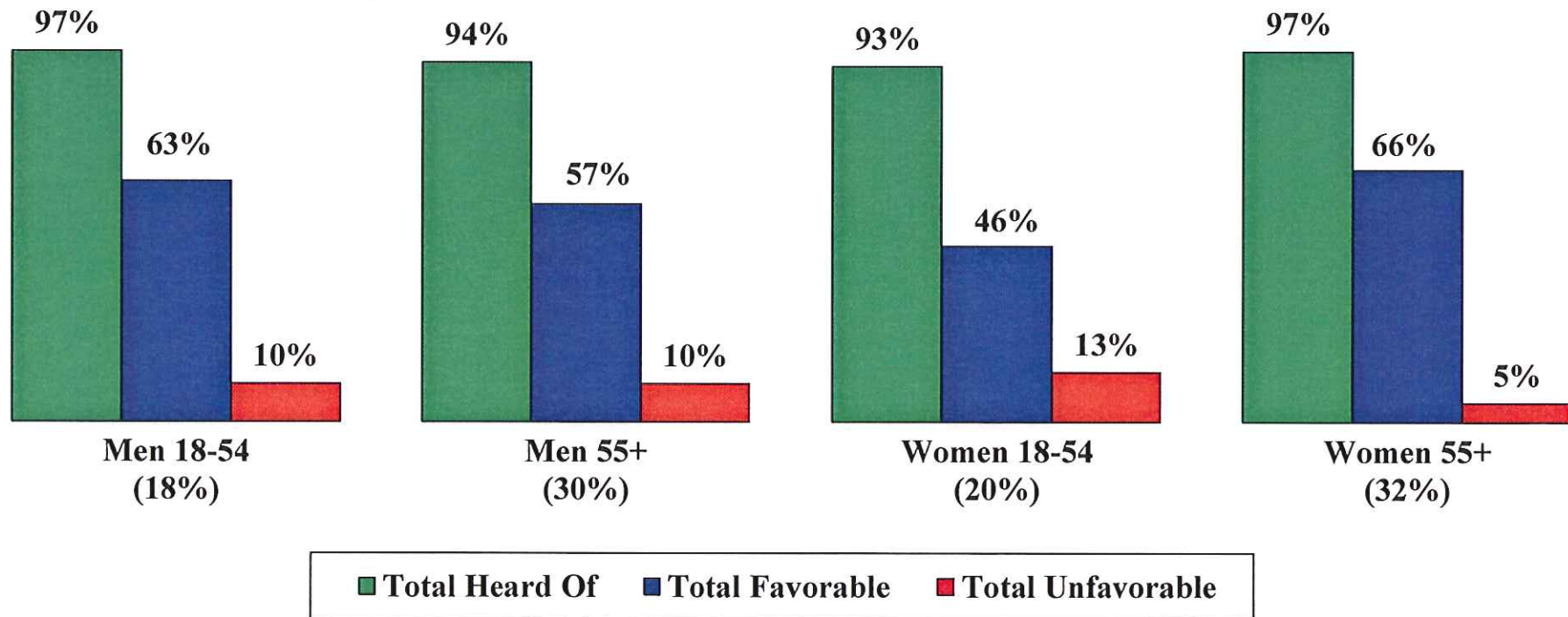
# Tarkanian's ID and image are especially strong in Las Vegas and Pahrump.

*Tarkanian ID/Image by City*



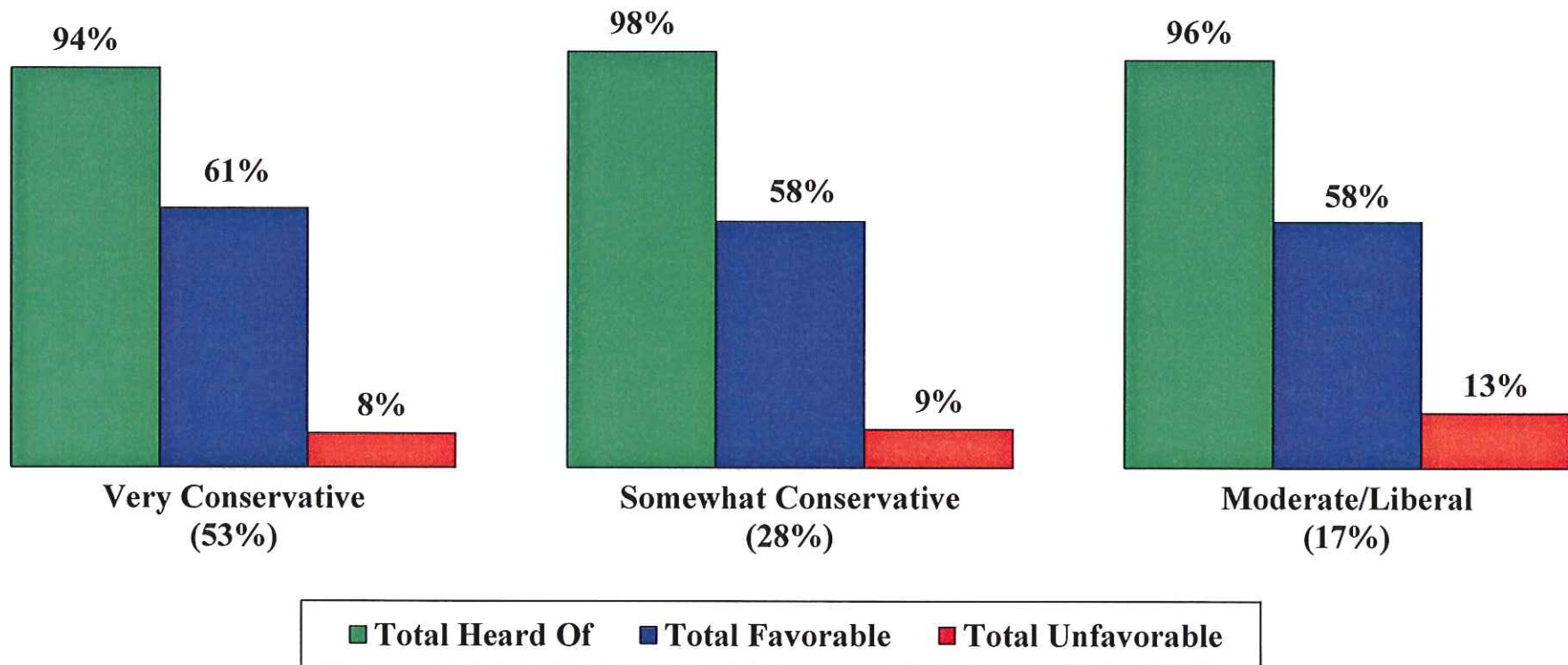
# Tarkanian has solid fav/unfav ratings across GOP primary voter gender/age groups.

*Tarkanian ID/Image by Gender/Age*



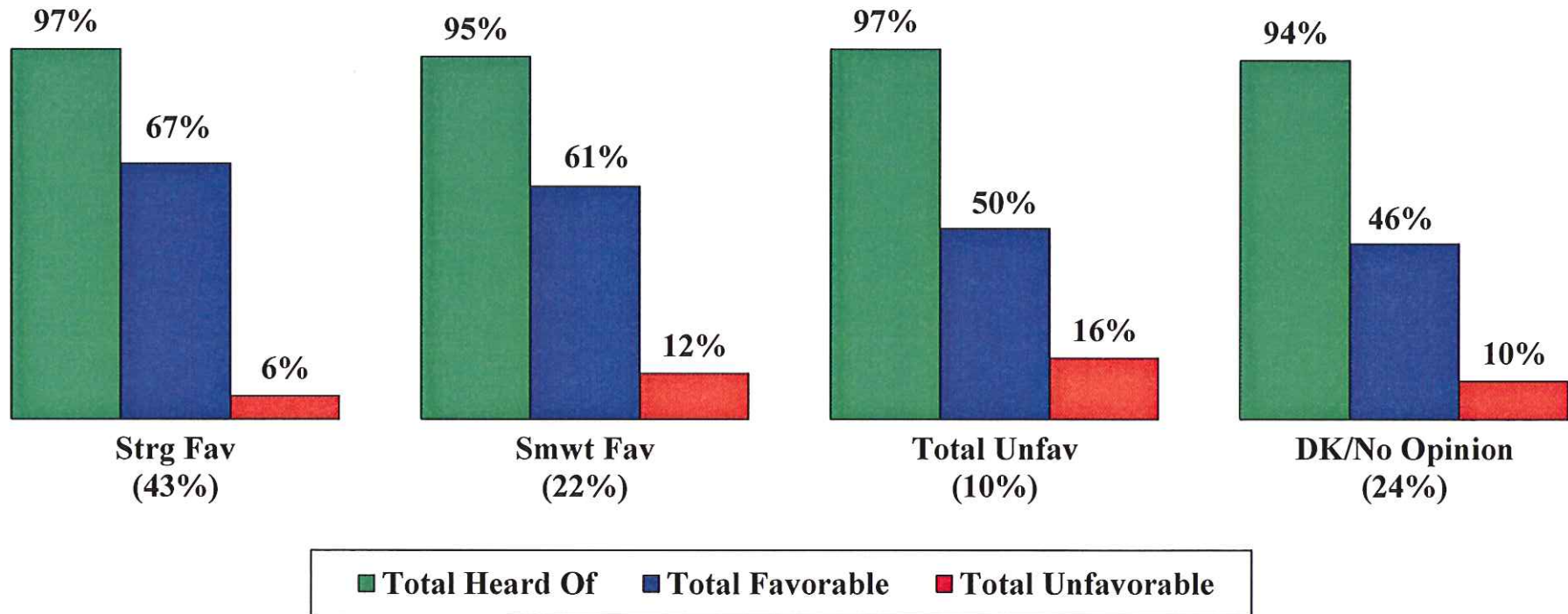
# Tark's favs among very conservative and moderate/liberal GOP primary voters are similar.

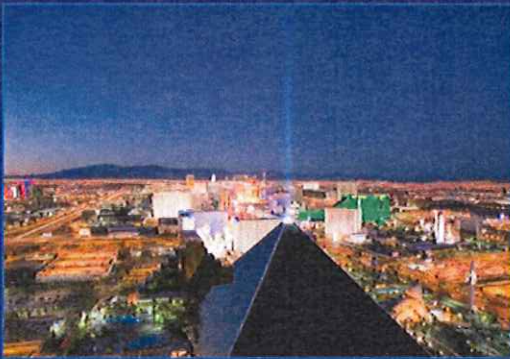
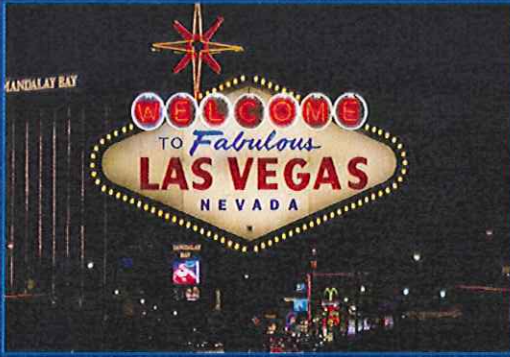
*Tarkanian ID/Image by Ideology*

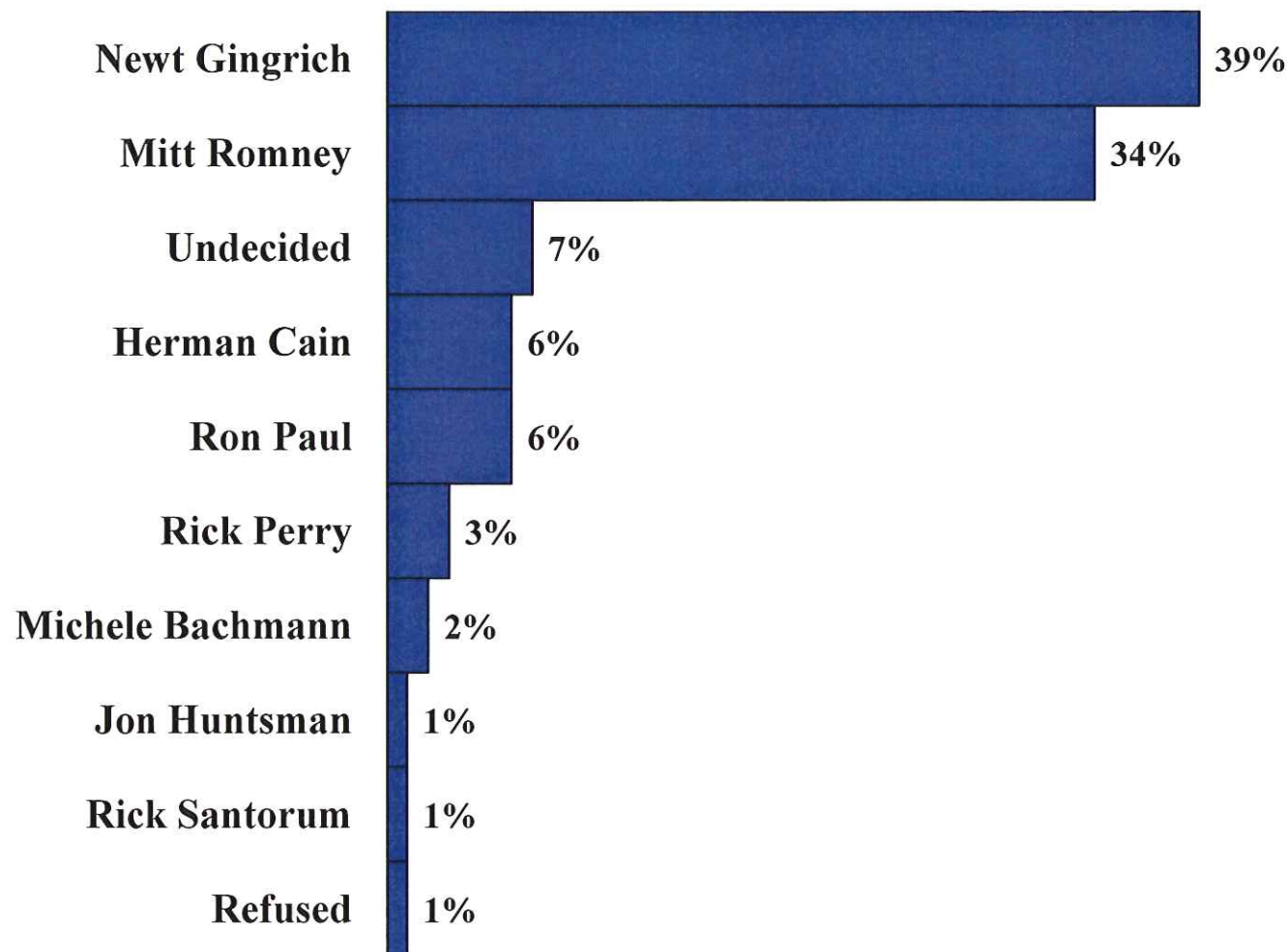




# Ballot Tests

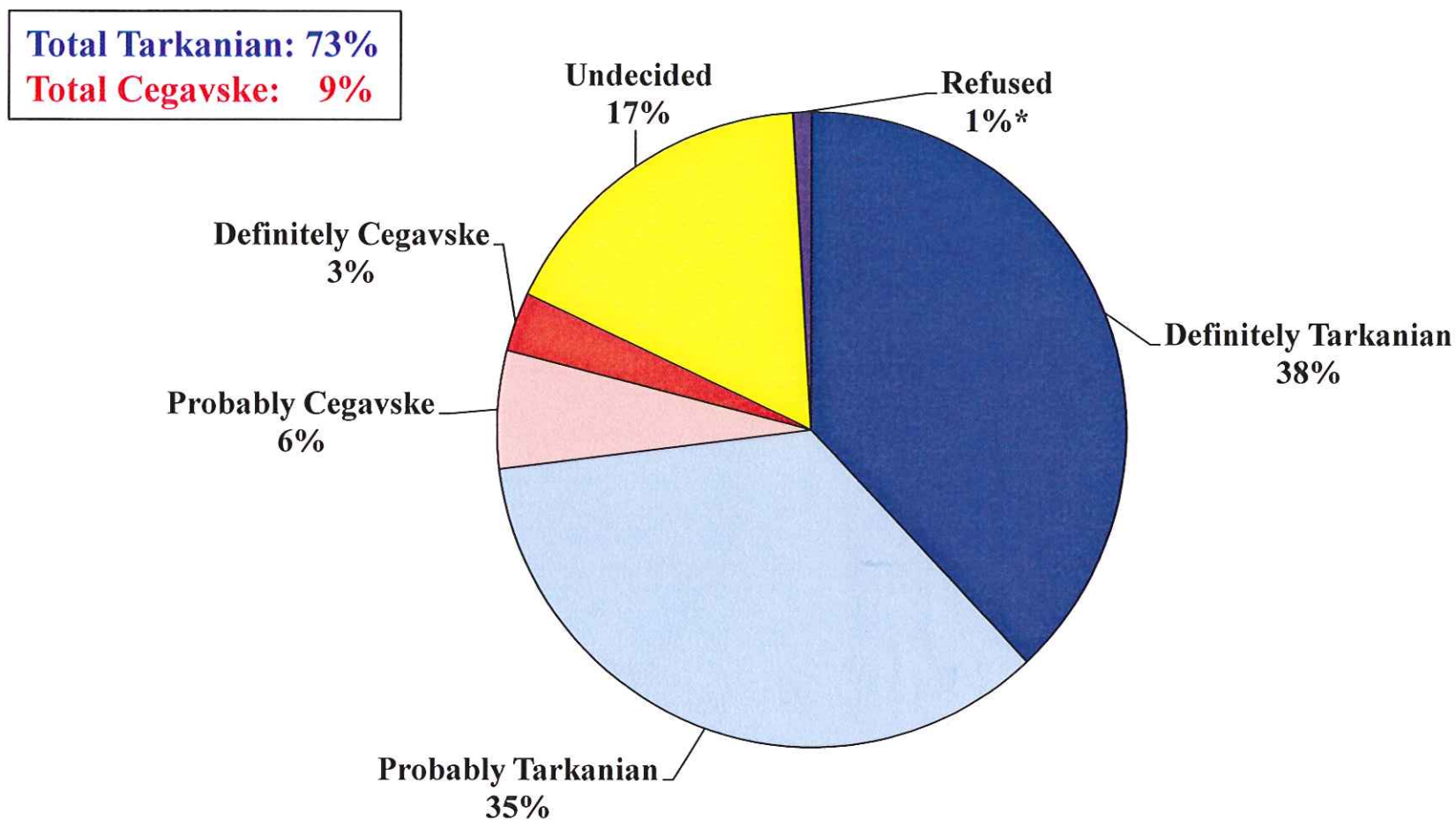
# Gingrich edges out Romney among GOP primary voters.

*“And if the Republican primary election for US Congress were being held today, for whom would you vote if the candidates were Danny Tarkanian and Barbara Cegavske?”*

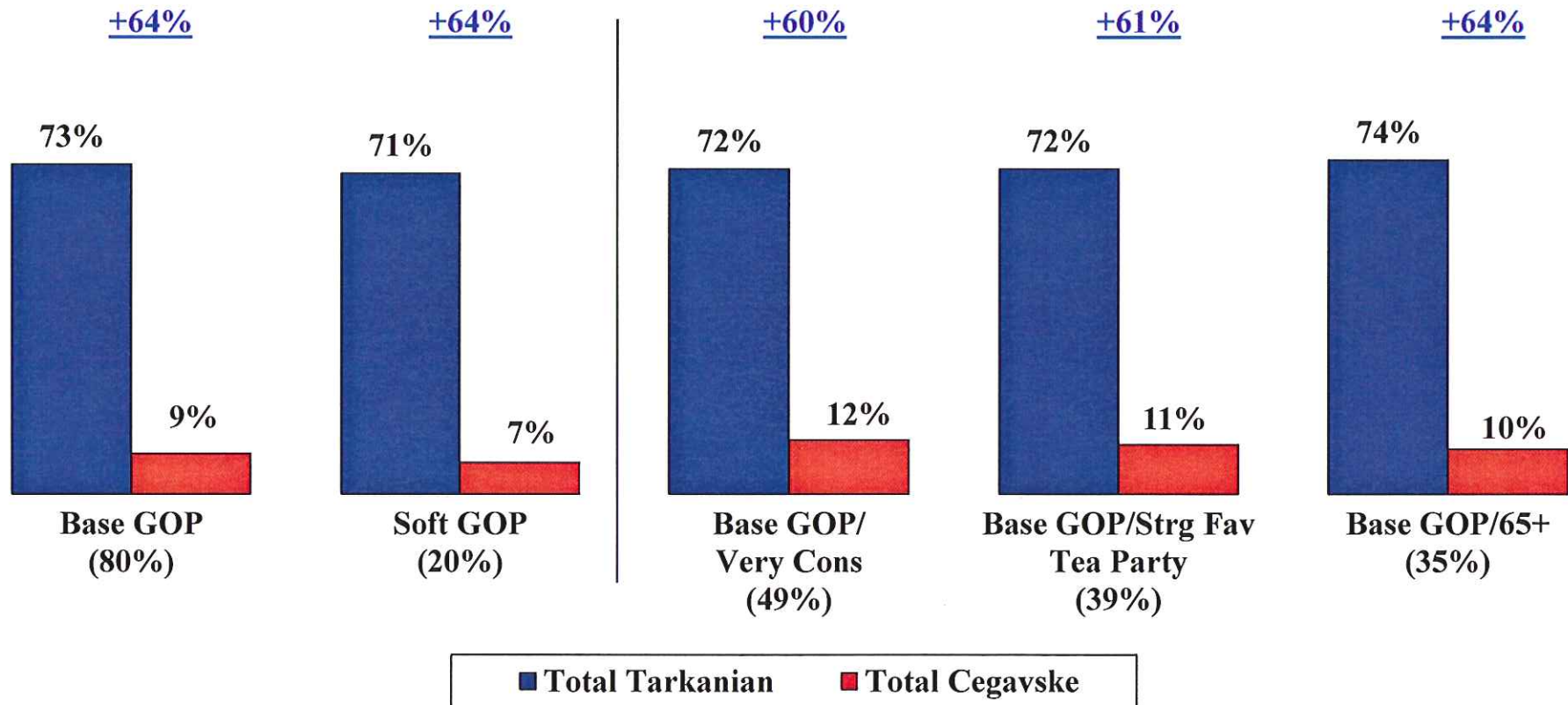

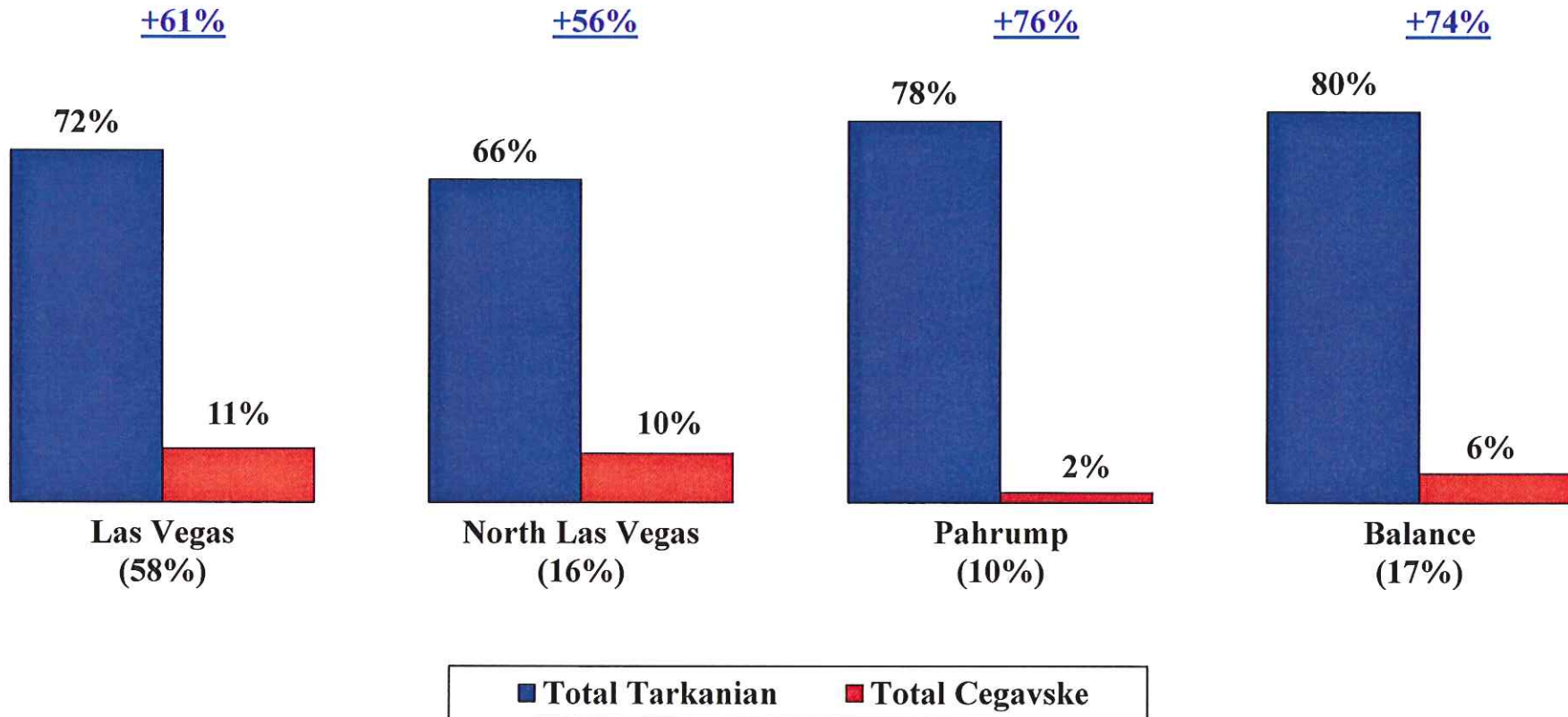
# Tarkanian dominates the ballot across the spectrum of GOP primary voters.

*Ballot by Party/Core*



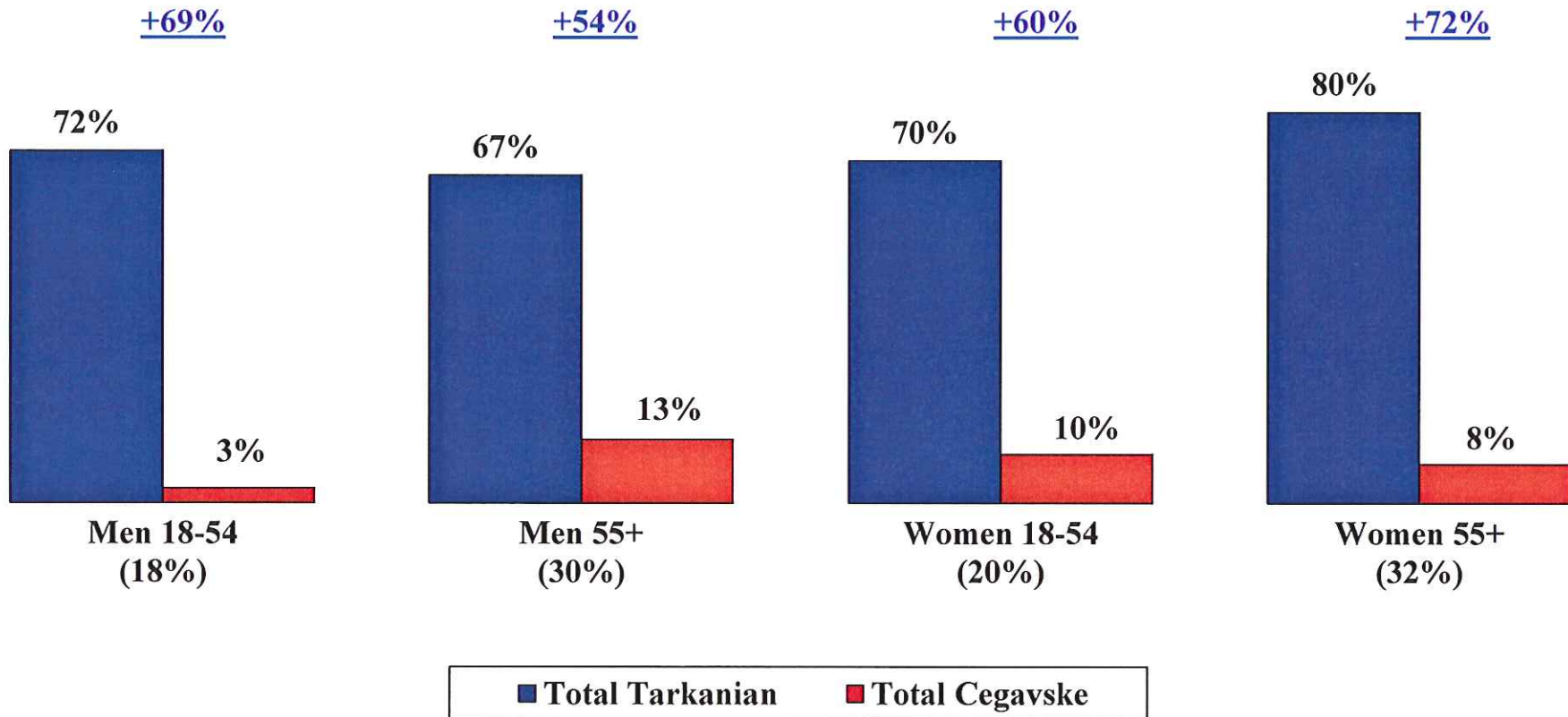
# Tarkanian has very strong support across geographic lines.

*Ballot by City*



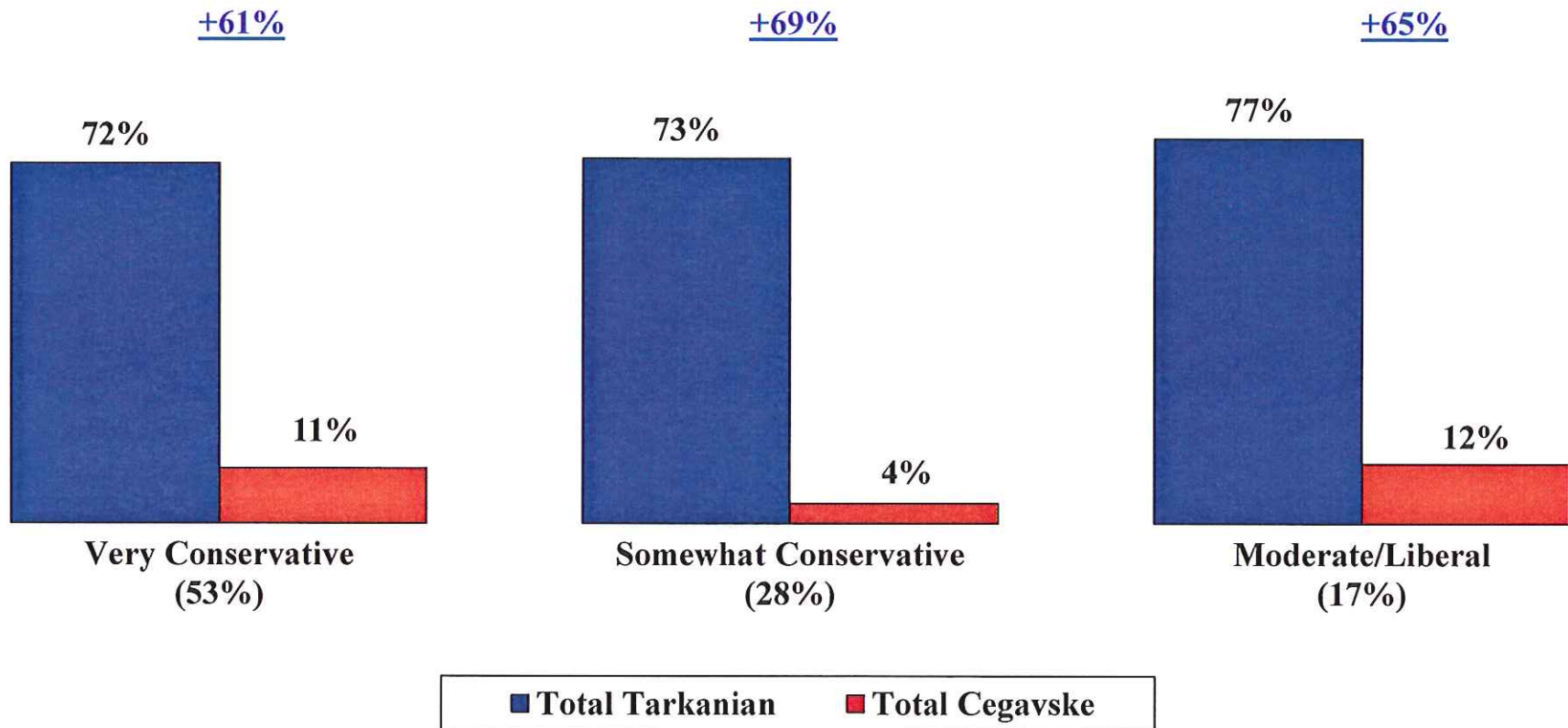
# GOP primary voters across gender/age lines support Tarkanian.

*Ballot by Gender/Age*



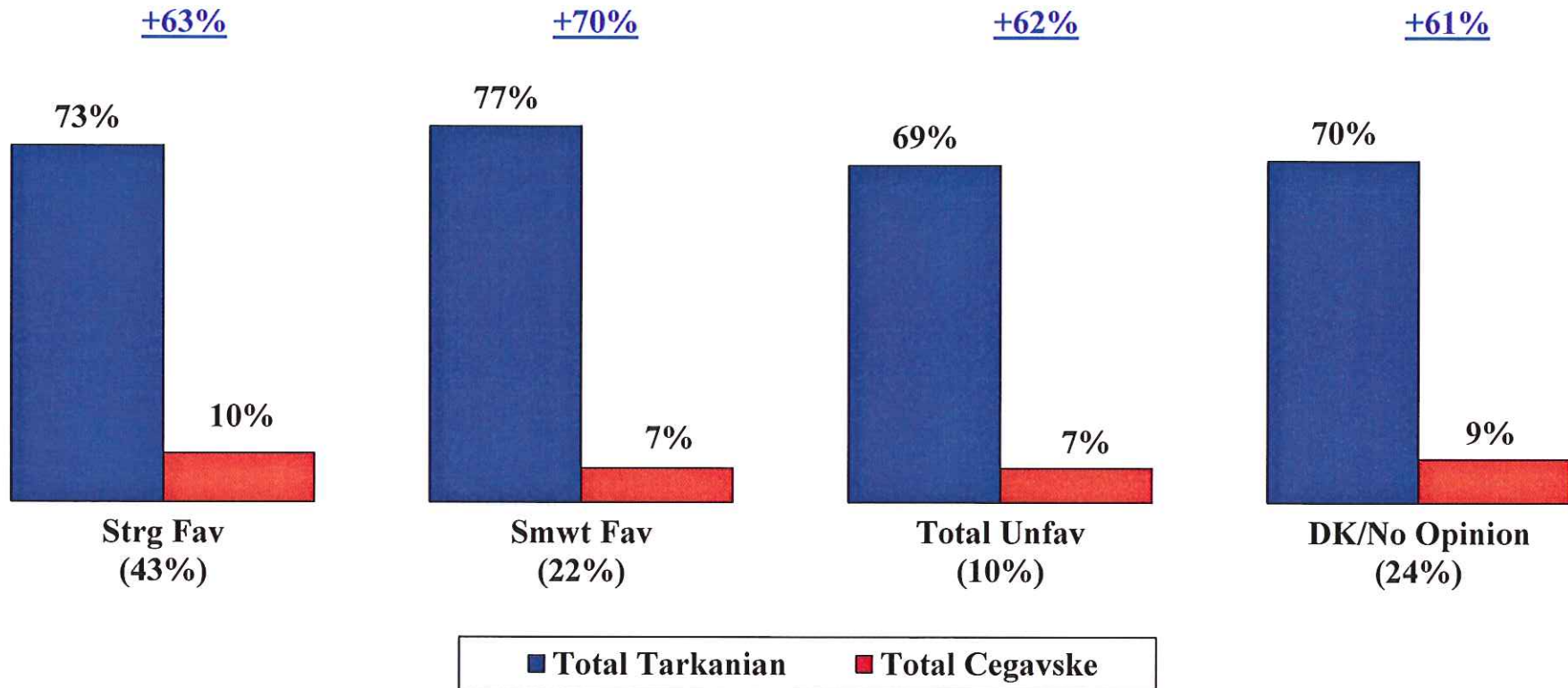
# Somewhat conservative GOP primary voters overwhelmingly support Tarkanian.

*Ballot by Ideology*



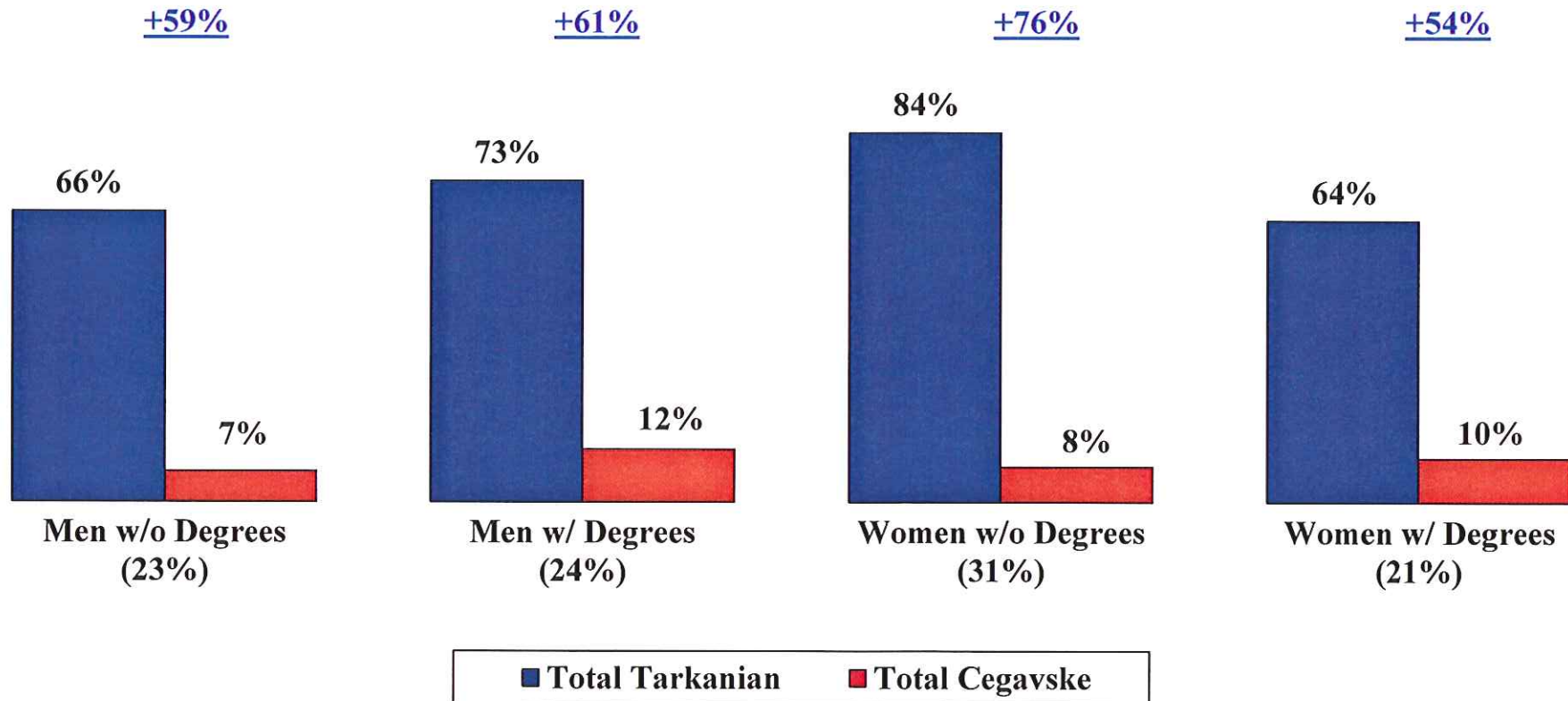
# Tea Party support is not a factor.

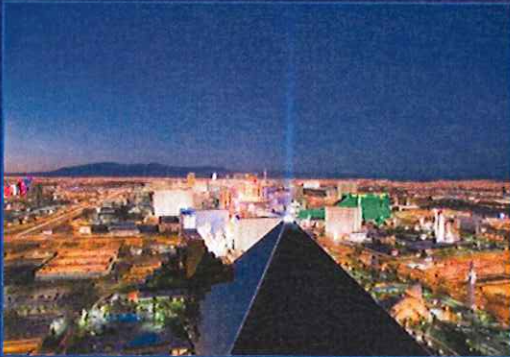
*Ballot by Tea Party Image*

*Ballot by Gender/Education*



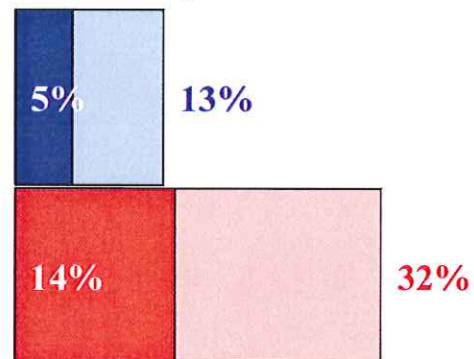


# Message Testing

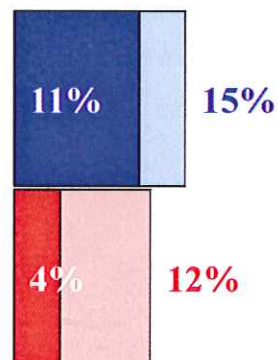
## Neither negative hit is very strong.
