DETECTIVE D. YOUNG, being first duly sworn, deposes and says:

That he is a police officer with the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department, being so employed for a period of six years, assigned to investigate the crime of BATTERY committed on or about November 15, 2010, which investigation has developed FLOYD JOY MAYWEATHER as the perpetrator thereof.

**THAT DECLARANT DEVELOPED THE FOLLOWING FACTS IN THE COURSE OF THE INVESTIGATION OF SAID CRIME TO WIT:**

That on November 15, 2010, Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Officers responded to the area of [REDACTED] Las Vegas, Nevada 89141, within the County of Clark to investigate a Battery.

Upon arriving, uniform LVMPD officers came into contact with Southern Highland Security Officer Shayne Smith, DOB 12-10-1988, who reported the following:

That while on routine patrol he observed two vehicles parked in front of Floyd Mayweather's home located at [REDACTED]. Said vehicles, being described as a grey Ford Explorer and a silver Mercedes 550. These vehicles were in violation of local homeowner association parking regulations. After observing the above listed violations, Smith alleges he exited his security vehicle and placed parking violation stickers on the two vehicles.

After placing the warning stickers on the vehicles, Smith stated he drove his security vehicle down [REDACTED] and maneuvered a U-turn at the end of the cul-de-sac. While passing in front of Mayweather's home and attempting to leave the area, Smith observed Mayweather standing in the roadway blocking his exit.

Smith alleges Mayweather was markedly agitated and screamed he had no "fucking" business touching his personal property. While being verbally abusive to Smith, Mayweather, who had removed one of the warning stickers from his vehicle, slapped the sticker on the front windshield of Smith's patrol vehicle. Mayweather then continued with his tantrum and demanded that Smith not touch his private property because he did not pay for the vehicles.

While lambasting Smith, Mayweather was allegedly jabbing his finger into the left side of Smith's cheek just below his eye. This willful and unlawful use of force and violence upon Smith caused redness and discoloration to the area which was battered by Mayweather.

Smith alleges that after being battered by Mayweather he drove out of the area to de-escalate the situation. While driving away, Smith immediately notified his superior, Security Lieutenant Kebles, who responded to the area and took digital photographs of Smith's injuries, as well as the parking sticker placed on his windshield by Mayweather.

At approximately 1739 hours, security dispatch contacted LVMPD officers who responded and completed a preliminary investigation. During their investigation LVMPD Sergeant Kleehammer made contact with Mayweather at his residence. Mayweather, through a glass door, refused to speak with officers.

On Sunday November 21, 2010, I, Detective D. Young, P# 8252, of the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department's Robbery/Homicide Bureau, Violent Crimes Section, met with Security Officer Smith at his place of employment and obtained the security department incident report Smith completed. Declarant also reviewed the photographs of the incident. I questioned Smith as to how he knew the perpetrator of the said crime was Floyd Mayweather. Smith related he knew it was Floyd Mayweather because of his celebrity.

The pictures I observed showed redness and discoloration to the left side of Smith's face. This photographic evidence ripened my suspicion that Smith was indeed battered.


On November 24, 2010, I made contact with Sonia Sosa, a dispatcher for Southern Highlands Security. Sonia provided me with a copy of their dispatch notes or CAD report. She additionally emailed me the photographs taken of Security Officer Smith immediately after the battery.


Because Floyd Mayweather did willfully and unlawfully use force or violence upon the person of another, Shayne Smith, by repeatedly poking him in the face with his finger, I pray that a warrant of arrest be issued for Battery.

Wherefore, declarant prays that a Warrant of Arrest be issued for suspect FLOYD JOY MAYWEATHER on a charge of BATTERY.
